



Agency Fees in Polish sea ports General Conditions Scale of Agency Fees

1st July 2008

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- A. The scale of Agency Fees, adopted by the Association, based on vessel's summer maximum loadline dead-weight and expressed in PLN covering clearance, port operation and ship's husbandry, is to be regarded as the recommended minimum rate level to be charged by the Agents.
- B. Owners, respectively Operators, shall place the Agents in funds, covering the estimated disbursements, in advance, but latest on vessel's arrival. For late remittances of funds Owners will be charged interest at 5% per month or pro rata.
- C. Agents are not responsible for currency exchange losses on any sums held for the account of the Owners or which they have to receive or pay.
- D. The Agency Fees do not include any percentages, petties, bank charges, fares, deliveries of cash to Master or parcels, advertising, travelling, etc. which will be charged separately.
- E. Should Owners require the Agents to undertake full processing and settlement of claims, the Agents are entitled to a separate remuneration as mutually agreed.

Rules for application of Basic Agency Fees:

- 1. Vessels discharging and loading bulk basic fee to be applied separately for or liquid cargo of one grade each of these operations
- 2. Vessels arriving with inward cargo and -basic fee to applied once only sailing in ballast or vessels arriving in ballast and sailling with outward cargo
- 3. Vessels carrying cargo in bales, bags, -10% surcharge on basic fee packages, containers, boxes on pallets, otherwise unitised, also forest and steel products

NOTE: This surcharge is not applicable to vessels carrying homogeneous cargo, where of a certain percentage is bagged for safe stowage

- 4. Vessels carrying mixed cargo of two or -20% surcharge on basic fee more distinctly different commodities, liquid, bulk, unitized, vehicles
- 5. Gas tankers of up to 10.000 cbm cargo basic fee plus 30% to be applied capacity basic fee plus 30% to be applied on cubic metre tank capacity

exceeding 10.000 cbm capacity - basic fee plus 20% to be applied on cubic metre tank capacity

NOTE: Cubic metre tank capacity substituting DWTAT on the fee scale

- 6. Pure Car Carriers -20% surcharge on basic fee
- 7. Reefer vessels 20% surcharge on basic fee
- 8. Ro-ro vessels 20% surcharge on basic fee
- 9. Cruise and passenger vessels, ferry boats fee to be negotiated
- 10. Fishing trawlers and factory vessels -fee to be negotiated
- 11. Vessels calling both Szczecin 25% surcharge on basic fee and Świnoujście
- 12. Vessels cleared in roads 10% surcharge on basic fee
- 13. Vessels entering port for replenishing -50% of the basic fee bunkers, water, provisions, seeking shelter in case of adverse weather or damage
- 14. Vessels entering port seeking medical aid 25% of the basic fee
- 15. a. Vessels entering port or shipyard for -75% of the basic fee and PLN 80,-p/day repairs or dry-docking
 b. Newbuildings leaving shipyard -75% of the basic fee
- 16. Arranging delivery/redelivery on or off -35% of the basic fee
 Time Charter

Rules for application of Basic Agency Fees:

- 17. Attendance as supervisory or Owners' protecting Agents when vessel is consigned to and handled by another company acting as Charterers Agents
- 50% of the basic fee
- 18. Attendance to crew members/person a. joining or leaving the vessel
- -PLN 80,-perperson
- b.hospitalised or requiring medical care -PLN 200,-per person per week
- 19. In case of handling non-liner vessels carrying general cargo on liner terms, Agents are entitled to charge a commission of PLN 2,00 per ton inwards and PLN 4,00 outwards.

20. Ocean going tugs

-PLN 1200,-inward

-PLN 1200,-outward

21. Minimum Agency Fee per call

-PLN 2100,-

LINER AGENCIES

For services provided to shipping lines calling Polish Ports directly or operating via European base ports on through bill of lading, Agents should be remunerated as per following schedule:

1. Freight Commission.

Outward:

5% for cargo canvassed and booked

2,5% for cargo handled but booked elsewhere

Inward:

2,5% for cargo canvassed and booked

1,5% for cargo handled but booked elsewhere

1% collection fee on freight for cargo on which no commission has been earned

Agents are entitled to receive commission on surcharges and freight additionals, provided these can be reasonably considered as actual freight increases.

The freight commission covers following functions: announcing sailings, tariff information, marketing and sales, issuing freight documents, collecting and remitting freights, etc.


Should for some reasons the required details not be disclosed or otherwise not available, the Agents are entitled to charge a commission of PLN 2,00 per ton inwards and PLN 4,00,- outwards.

- 2. Container and ISO equipment logistic fee. PLN 100,- per unit handled, controlled, monitored and reported by the Agents.
- 3. Agency fee. Charged for clearance and ship's husbandry as per Basic Agency Fees scale.

The above charges are applicable also in case of incidental calls of liner vessels loading or discharging general or containerised cargo in absence of a concluded Agency Agreement.



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
