PROHIBITION OF SIGN-ON CREW WITH TRAVEL HISTORY TO THE UNITED KINGDOM FOR CREW CHANGE IN SINGAPORE

- 1. The Ministry of Health has announced that from 23 December 2020, 2359 hours, all long-term pass holders and short-term visitors with recent travel history to the United Kingdom (UK) within the last 14 days will <u>not</u> be allowed entry into Singapore, or transit through Singapore.
- 2. In line with the above, please be informed that the following crew change will not be allowed in the Port of Singapore:
 - a) Sign-on crew with travel history to the UK within the last 14 days
 - b) Sign-on crew transiting UK on their connecting flights to Singapore
- 3. The above measure is effective from 23 December 2020, 2359 hours and will remain in effect until further notice.
