Travel restrictions for Travellers arriving from South African Countries

As a new COVID-19 variant called "nu" has been detected from South African Countries, travellers with a travel history (including transit) in the past 14 days to South Africa, Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia, Zimbabwe and Eswatini (Swaziland) will not be permitted to disembark in Sri Lanka from 00:00 on 28th of November 2021 and onwards.

Irrespective of COVID-19 vaccination status Travellers of twelve years and above who are arriving in Sri Lanka on 26th and 27th of November 2021 from above mentioned countries shall undergo Day One (On Arrival PCR) testing at a Ministry of Health approved laboratory at Katunayake or at a Safe & Secure Certified Level 1 Hotel.

If the Day One PCR report is negative, they have to undergo mandatory Quarantine as follows:

- Sri Lankans, Dual Citizens, Valid Resident Visa holders and their spouses and children should undergo mandatory home quarantine until completion of 14 days. Once they arrive at their homes, they have to inform the area Medical Officer of Health (MOH).
- 2. Foreign national staff members of the diplomatic missions or UN organizations/ UN Specialized agencies/ International Organizations with permanent offices in Sri Lanka (mentioned in Annex 01) and their accompanying spouse, parents and children should undergo mandatory quarantine at an area Medical Officer of Health approved residence/ Safe and Secure Certified Level 1 hotel until completion of 14 days. Once they arrive at the residences, they have to inform area MOH.
- All other travellers should undergo quarantine at a Safe and Secure Certified Level 1 hotel until completion of 14 days

All travellers of 12 years and above should undergo COVID-19 PCR/ Rapid Antigen testing at a Ministry of Health approved lab (Private sector or state sector) on Day 14 and they will be released from quarantine with a negative COVID-19 Test report. Contacts of the positive travellers will have to undergo quarantine further as per the guidelines of Ministry of Health

Travellers who are symptomatic/having positive COVID-19 test reports will be managed as per the guidelines of Ministry of Health

This guideline will be revised depending on the COVID-19 situation in the country and the global situation.

Director General of Health Services as the Proper Authority for whole of Sri Lanka under the Quarantine and Prevention of Disease Ordinance No. 03 of 1897, can make directions deviating from this guideline without prior notice considering individual situations
