Transport – how to get there and getting around in Cambridge

Cambridge is located 50 miles (approx. 80 km) north of London and is well-served by road, rail and airport links.



Airport

London Stansted Airport is the closest to Cambridge. It is 30 miles (approx. 48 km) from Cambridge and takes 30 minutes by train.



Rail

There are direct train connections from London Kings Cross, St Pancras, Blackfriars and Liverpool Street to Cambridge. The train journey takes from 50 minutes to 1 hour and 20 minutes depending on the connection.



Car

The closest public car park is Park Street (less than a 5-minute walk from WYNG Gardens) and more information about pricing and location etc. is available at the Cambridge Council website (see useful links below).



Taxi

If you are arriving by taxi please ask your driver to take you to WYNG Gardens, Thompson’s Lane. (If you asked for Trinity Hall the taxi will take you to the main College on Trinity Lane and then it is a 10-minute walk to Thompson’s Lane.) Please refer to the attached maps for details.

Accommodation

WYNG Gardens bedrooms include:

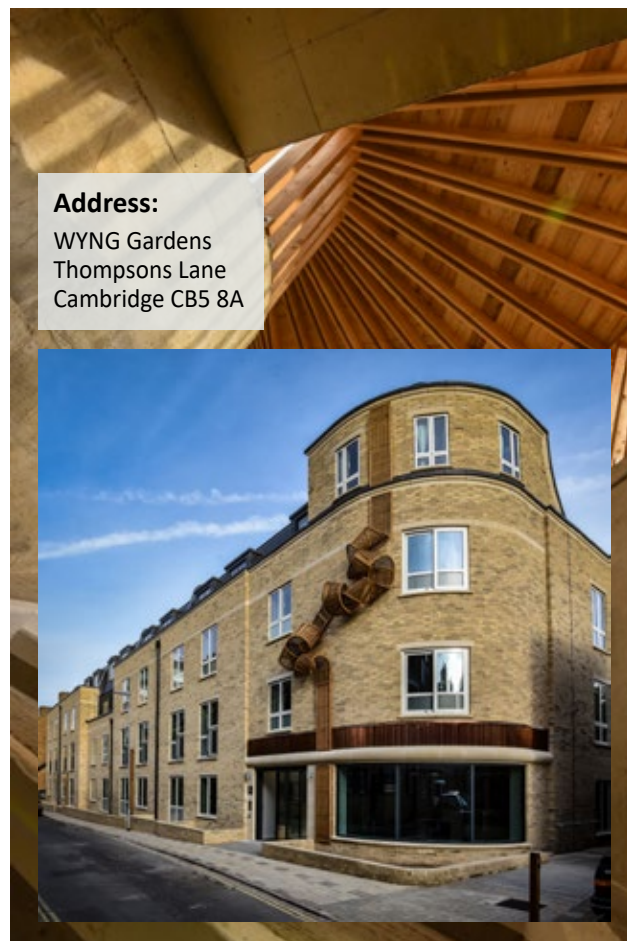
- ▶ En-suite bathroom with shower.

Practical information

Weather

Be prepared for a little bit of rain, as the summers in England can be unpredictable. Hopefully, there will be a lot of sunshine!

Daytime outdoor temperatures during the summer months can get up to 28C (82F) on sunnier days with some humidity.

Please note that there is no air conditioning in your accommodation, as it is not typical in United Kingdom to have air conditioning – most of the year it is not needed. We recommend you bring a light jacket and a sweater or cardigan for the cooler evenings.

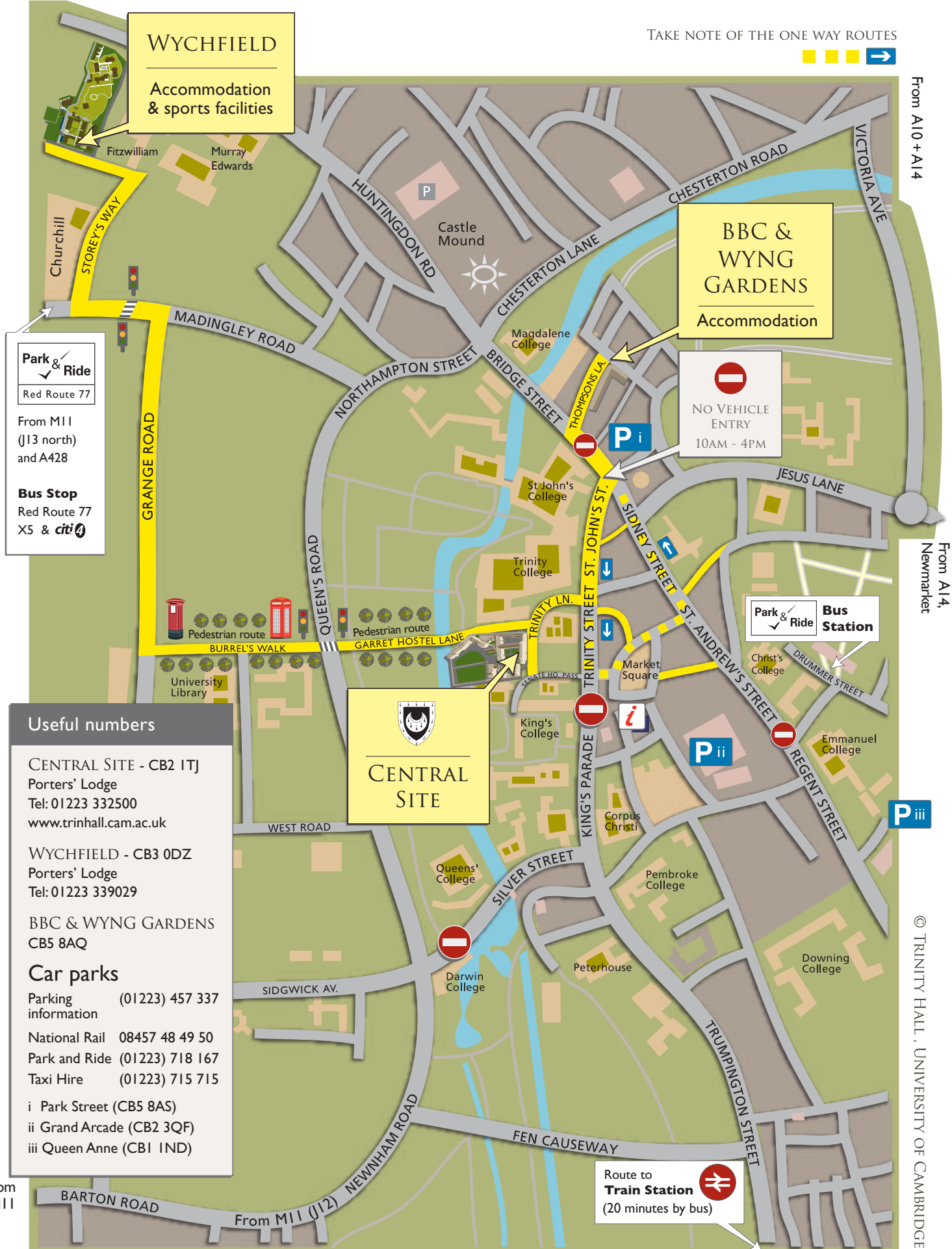
