### Transport – how to get there and getting around in Cambridge

Cambridge is located 50 miles (approx. 80 km) north of London and is well-served by road, rail and airport links.



#### Airport

London Stansted Airport is the closest to Cambridge. It is 30 miles (approx. 48 km) from Cambridge and takes 30 minutes by train.



#### Rail

There are direct train connections from London Kings Cross, St Pancras, Blackfriars and Liverpool Street to Cambridge. The train journey takes from 50 minutes to 1 hour and 20 minutes depending on the connection.



#### Car

The closest public car park is Park Street (less than a 5-minute walk from WYNG Gardens) and more information about pricing and location etc is available at the Cambridge Council website (see useful links below).



#### Taxi

If you are arriving by taxi please ask your driver to take you to WYNG Gardens, Thompson’s Lane. (If you asked for Trinity Hall the taxi will take you to the main College on Trinity Lane and then it is a 10-minute walk to Thompson’s Lane.) Please refer to the attached maps for details.



#### Pedestrian

Yellow route on map indicates pedestrian route to Trinity Hall Central Site, CB2 1TJ and Wychfield, CB3 0DZ.

## Accommodation

WYNG Gardens (see map on page 8), a popular new conference venue in central Cambridge, provides high quality, contemporary conference facilities, meeting rooms and en-suite overnight accommodation for delegates.

WYNG Gardens bedrooms include:

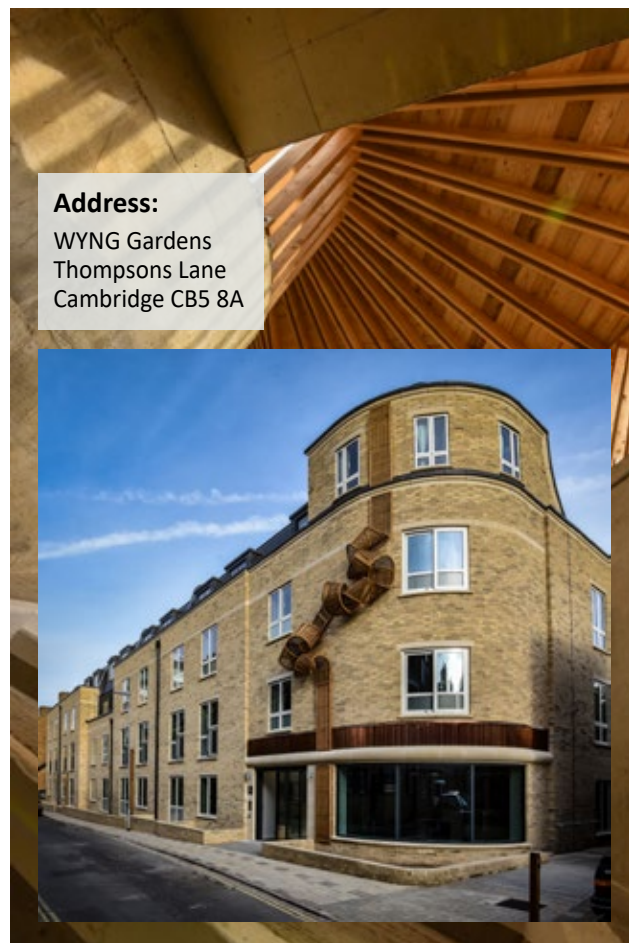
- ▶ en-suite bathroom with shower

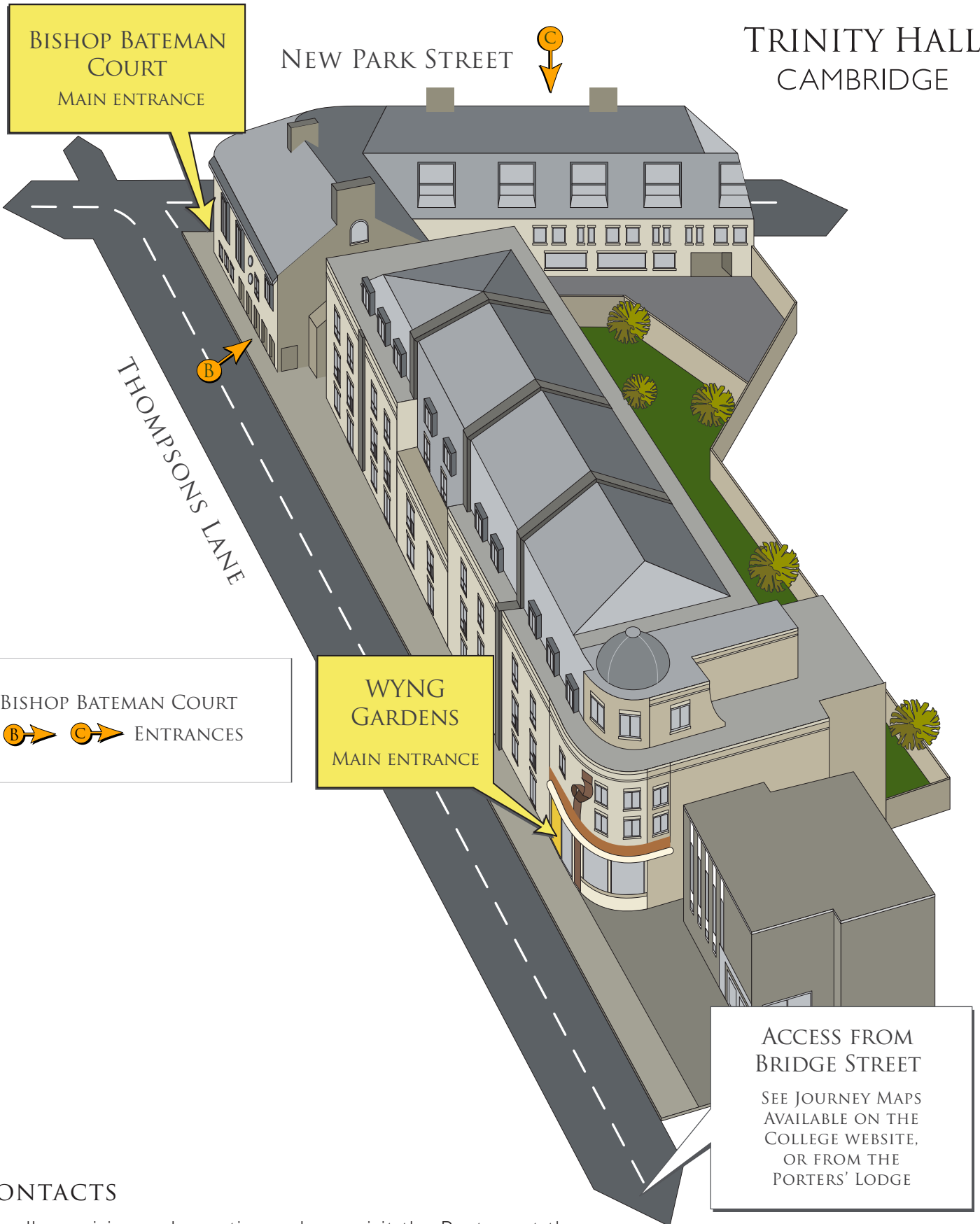
